Entry Rules:

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on January 21, 2012.

Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical Rules will be in effect.

Entries must be submitted electronically, using Hy-Tek or compatible Software.

In the event the meet is oversubscribed, the meet director and the meet referee will work together to determine the solution in the best interest of the swimmers.

USA Swimming Registration:

All swimmers must be currently registered with USA Swimming, Inc. Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar.

ALL Swimmers MUST be Registered, with the AD Registrar, by the Meet Entry Deadline.

All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. ([Click Here for More Information](#))

NOTE: ALL ATHLETES ATTENDING ANY SANCTIONED MEET, MUST BE UNDER THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A CURRENTLY REGISTERED AND CERTIFIED, USA SWIMMING COACH MEMBER. IF YOU ARE AN UNATTACHED ATHLETE, OR YOUR COACH WILL NOT BE ATTENDING THE MEET, YOU AND/OR YOUR COACH, MUST CONTACT THE MEET DIRECTOR OR AN ATTENDING COACH, IN ADVANCE, TO MAKE ARRANGEMENTS FOR AN ATTENDING COACH TO ASSUME RESPONSIBILITY FOR YOU.

This is a USA Swimming Rule, there are no exceptions.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Swimming Events:

All events will be swum as timed finals. Swimmers and coaches are responsible for knowing the events for which they are entered.

POSITIVE CHECK-IN:

- **Session 2 – By 11:15 AM - FOR ALL EVENTS (500 Freestyle, 200 Butterfly, 200 Backstroke, 200 Breaststroke and 400 IM)**
- **Session 3 – By 2:30 PM - FOR 1000 Freestyle**

Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area. Warm-up procedures will be posted to the web prior to the meet.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries. Team lane assignments will be posted to the web prior to the meet.

Swimmers have to provide their own timers for any Session 2 (mid-session) events.

Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets
2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show Proof of Registration (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered). Acceptable forms of Proof of Registration are: USA-Swimming ID or USA-Swimming Club Portal Current Team Listing. **If athlete cannot prove USA-S Registration, Adirondack accepts Deck Registration, to UN-AD (unattached) at a fee of \$108. DECK REGISTRATIONS WILL NOT BE MADE WITH ANY TEAM ASSOCIATION, PLEASE DO NOT ASK.**
3. Coach makes the request for the entry.
4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.
5. Deck Entries are Subject to a \$1.00 Surcharge, Per Entry, which applies to All Entries, Individual or Relays.

Meet Policy:

Use of Audio or Visual Recording Devices, Including a Cell Phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members. **No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials, USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift. All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck.**

If, at and AD Sanctioned Meet, an individual is found on deck, acting in any coaching capacity and is determined to be out of compliance with USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.

Services:

Food will be on sale throughout the meet. No food or drink will be allowed on deck. A swimming equipment vender will be selling equipment during the meet. This is a non smoking building. No glass containers are allowed in the pool area.

Photographers:

Any photographer or videographer, who intends to take pictures at an Adirondack Swimming sanctioned meet, must complete and submit a Photographer Registration Form to the Meet Director before commencing activity. Swimmer's families, taking photos of their children from the spectator area, are not subject to this policy.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Entry Fees:

An entry summary sheet is included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$3.50 per individual event (these include the \$.50 AD travel fund surcharge), \$6.00 per relay (including the \$1.00 AD travel fund surcharge) plus a \$1.00 per swimmer surcharge.

ALL MANUAL ENTRIES (not submitted electronically) WILL HAVE A SURCHARGE OF \$1.00 PER ENTRY (Individual or Relay).

Awards:

For individual events medals will be awarded for 1st – 3rd places and ribbons for 4th -6th places.

Relay event ribbons will be awarded to the 1st - 3rd place teams.

Heat ribbons will be awarded for all individual events 12 & under

Officials:

There will be an official's meeting conducted promptly 30 minutes before each session. Attendance is MANDATORY to work the meet.

Directions:

Take the New York State Thruway to Exit 19, Kingston. Take the 3rd exit off the Rotary onto Col. Chandler Drive (587). Stay in the right lane and follow to the first light. Go straight through the light, (signs say South 32). The road bears left and merges onto Broadway (which is also 32 South). Follow Broadway for .8miles, to the Kingston High School. Take the first entrance of the horseshoe drive and drive past the front entrance of the school. The pool will be straight ahead. This is the swimmer drop off area. Park in the parking lot near the pool. If this is filled, you may need to park on Broadway or follow signs for additional parking.
