Spectator Limitations:

In compliance to Union College Event Rules, SPECTATOR NUMBERS will be RESTRICTED.

People working the meet from participating clubs are permitted on deck for their scheduled slot.

The meet will be live-streamed to the Sharks YouTube channel, which can be found at the link below. Everyone who subscribes to the channel will be notified when we begin to stream a session; in addition, if the internet connection at the pool becomes unstable and we have to begin a new stream within a session, subscribers will be notified of the new stream automatically. Otherwise, they can check the link close to the session start times and tune in to the link at that time.

Entry Rules:

The eligibility of a swimmer will be determined by his or her age on **December 11, 2022.**

Rules from the current USA Swimming Technical and Administrative Rules will be in effect.

Entries must be submitted electronically, using Hy-Tek, Team Unify or compatible Software and Emailed to the **Meet Entry Coordinator**. Team entries must be received by the Meet Entry Coordinator by **Sunday**, **December 4**, **2022**, **at 5:00PM**.

Please be certain you receive a reply confirming receipt of your entries within 48 hours; follow up if you do NOT receive a reply.

Session 1 swimmers (10 & Under) may enter a maximum of 4 individual events.

Session 2 swimmers (11-12) may enter a maximum of 5 individual events.

Only SCY times will be accepted.

Entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Once a session is full, no additional entries will be accepted for that session. The host team reserves the right to enter its swimmers at any time. If the meet is oversubscribed or undersubscribed, in an effort to keep session duration at approximately 3 hours, Events may have to be cut, and Meet and/or Session Start Times may be rescheduled. A decision regarding any changes will be made by the Meet Director AND the Meet Referee and will be made in consideration of the swimmers' best interest. Attending teams will be notified of any changes and/or cuts, and these will also be posted on the AD Web site. Any fees paid for cut entries will be refunded.

202.3.2 At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

202.3.4A Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement

USA Swimming Registration:

No swimmer will be permitted to compete unless the swimmer is a member as provided in Article 302.

Registrations may be obtained from your club registrar. All Adirondack Meets are reconciled for current USA Swimming Registration.

Unregistered swimmers will be removed from the meet and a \$25.00 Fine Imposed. (Click Here for More Information)

Athletes 18 or older MUST have completed APT to be compliant and allowed to swim in meet.

Swimming Events:

The meet will be pre-seeded and all events will be timed finals.

Starts will be Flyover Starts; please inform your swimmers prior to the meet.

8 & Under swimmers are to line up in the bull pen area for 25 yard events only.

5-10 minute breaks will be taken after every 4 events.

Warm-Ups:

Because of the large number of injuries occurring across the country during warm-ups, USA Swimming allows no diving into the pool during the warm-up period except in the designated sprint lanes. We ask that you inform your swimmers of this rule and ask them to fully cooperate with the club officials and marshals in charge of the area.

Timers:

Clubs will be required to provide timers based upon their number of entries.

Deck Entries:

Adirondack Swimming has agreed to allow Deck Entries at AD Meets under the following conditions;

- 1. Deck Entries are NOT Allowed during Championship Meets
- 2. Athlete must be USA-S Registered and show Proof of Registration (those already in meet have been confirmed as registered).

Acceptable forms of Proof of Registration are: USA-Swimming ID from SWIMS 3.0 or the USA Swimming Phone app.

- 3. Coach makes the request for the entry.
- 4. All Deck Entries will be allowed at the discretion of a combined decision of the Meet Director and the Meet Referee.
- 5. Deck Entries are Subject to a \$1.00 Surcharge, Per Entry, which applies to All Entries, Individual or Relays.

Meet Policy:

Use of Audio or Visual Recording Devices, including a Cell Phone, is not permitted behind the starting blocks, including any spectator area behind the starting blocks, in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

No one will be allowed on the deck except USA-S Registered Officials and USA-S Registered Coaches with Current Certifications, USA-S Registered Swimmers and Meet Marshalls and Timers on Shift.

All Officials and Coaches are Required to display USA Swimming Credentials (USA Swimming Membership Card) while on deck. If, at an AD Sanctioned Meet, an individual is found on deck, acting in any coaching capacity and is determined to be out of compliance with USA Swimming requirements for coaches, that individual will be removed from the deck and the represented club will be fined \$250.

Any swimmer found in an unauthorized area will be asked to immediately leave the premises. No exceptions. Each team is responsible for supervising its members.

All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.

An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. COVID-19 is an extremely contagious disease that can lead to severe illness and death. Services:

Spectators entering the pool will be charged \$5 per adult (kids are free) at the door and will receive free heat sheets.

Spectators watching the meet on the Sharks' YouTube channel will be able to see the heat sheets at no extra cost on Meet Mobile.

A basic selection of packaged snacks and bottled drinks will be on sale throughout the meet.

A swimming equipment vendor (Deep End) will be at the venue.

Smoking is NOT permitted in the building. Food and drink, except for water, are not permitted in the pool area. Glass containers of any kind are strictly prohibited in the pool area.

Disabled Athletes:

Adirondack Swimming welcomes athletes with disabilities. Athletes with disabilities are required to contact the Meet Director at least 2 weeks in advance of the meet so that provisions can be made for any special accommodations.

Entry Fees:

An entry summary sheet is included to compute your team entry fees. The entry fees are \$4.50 per individual event, which includes the \$.50 AD travel fund surcharge, \$7.00 per relay, which includes the \$1.00 AD travel fund surcharge and a \$2.00 per swimmer surcharge.

ALL MANUAL ENTRIES, INCLUDING DECK ENTRIES (NON-ELECTRONIC) ARE SUBJECT TO A SURCHARGE OF \$1.00 PER ENTRY, WHICH APPLIES TO INDIVIDUAL OR RELAY ENTRIES.

Make your entry check payable to SCHENECTADY-SARATOGA SWIM CLUB and mail your check and entry summary to the Meet Entry Coordinator. Entries will be entered to the meet upon receipt of your check.

Photographers:

Only Professional Photographers or Videographers hired by the host team or Press Photographers, who have been approved in advance by the meet director, will be allowed on deck. A Photographer Registration form must be completed and submitted to the meet director for approval, prior to the meet. Forms are available on the Adirondack Swimming website as well as from the Meet Director.

Swimmer's families, taking photos of their children from the spectator area, are not subject to this policy.
