Covid Change

The Union College COVID guidelines included in the meet announcement have changed and should be removed and replaced with the following:

The health of our community is a shared responsibility. Capacity Restrictions

Please also note there are still capacity restrictions at the Union College Pool. The meet is full and priority access will obviously be given to swimmers, coaches, officials, and parent volunteers. After those people are admitted, we will then allow general admission spectators up to the building capacity. There will be a \$5 admission charge for spectators.

Spectators will not be allowed into the pool area until after the warm-up time has started for each session.
