

Attention All AD Clubs,

USA Swimming Rule:

302.3 FALSE REGISTRATION — If a swimmer who is not properly registered with USA Swimming competes in a sanctioned competition, the host LSC may impose a fine of up to \$100.00 per event against the individual, member coach or member club submitting.

AD Policy

1. An athlete who is not registered when submitting entries to a meet will be removed from the meet file and **MUST** follow Deck Entry procedures if subsequently registered.

2. An athlete who is allowed to swim in an AD Sanctioned Meet and is determined, after the meet, to not have been registered at the time of the meet, the host club will be fined \$100.00, payable to Adirondack Swimming and the athlete will be disqualified from all events swum...

3. Proof of Registration for Deck Entries ...

If the meet allows Deck Entries and an athlete who is not already in the meet (already verified in the pre-meet recon) is requesting a deck entry, he/she **MUST PROVE REGISTRATION** by Displaying Member Card from SWIMS 3.0 on computer or USA Swimming Phone App.

No Exceptions! The word of a coach, parent or athlete is Not to be Accepted.

4. Deck Registration ...

With the inception of SWIMS 3.0 and Online Member Registration, which began September 1, 2022, Deck Registration is no longer allowed. Swimmers are responsible for their own registration to USA Swimming.
